1 Project website

The publicly accessible project website shall explain project concepts, publish partner-provided progress and deliverables, and generally provide a combined dissemination forum for R5-COP. As such, the website shall be easily accessible by both project partners uploading input and end-users consuming said input.

1.1 Technical background and reachability

The website comprises a back-end web server with a dedicated content-management service (CMS) running on top, allowing easy content modification by authorized users. It particularly consists of

- the well-known and highly configurable Apache web server¹ as the back-end server, and
- DjangoCMS², which was chosen for its robustness, safety and stability, relative ease of use and rich feature sets. Of particular interest to R5-COP are
 - built-in support of Editorial Workflow in combination with fine-grain Permission Management and Versioning,
 - the Media Asset Manager for easy management of various document types (PDF, pictures, videos, audio streams, ...),
 - the flexible Plugin architecture and Apps support,
 - built-in Search-Engine Optimization, and
 - Multi-language support, in case partners plan to publish dedicated national sub-pages.

For the project, the domain `r5-cop.eu` could be secured; therefore, the web server is reachable via the URLs `www.r5-cop.eu` and `r5-cop.eu`, allowing maximum reachability.

1.2 Initial content

The server was filled with initial content comprising a draft project outline, the individual partner names and logos (with back-links to their own web sites), and corresponding logos of funding entities. From this state, the dissemination team will continue to update the site with current information and latest deliverables.
